FEES

8.01 ANIMALS.

A. Dog and Cat Licenses.

- (1) (a) Neutered male dog or cat: \$5.00
- (b) Spayed female dog or cat: \$5.00
- (c) Unneutered male dog or cat
or unspayed female dog or
cat: \$10.00
- (2) Late Fees. \$5.00
- (3) Replacement Tags. \$.50

8.02 BICYCLES.

- A. Registration fee, permanent: \$5.00.
- B. Registration fee, transfer: \$3.00.

8.03 BUILDING CODE.

A. Building Contractors' Licenses.

- (1) Initial building contractor's license: \$50.00
- (2) Renewal license: \$30.00

B. Building Permit Fees.

- (1) New Construction (including additions).
 - (a) Single family dwellings and duplexes:
 - (1) Plan approval fee: \$50.00; and
 - (2) Building Permit fee: \$50.00 plus \$0.200 per square foot of floor area (maximum fee of \$500.00); and
 - (3) Accessory Buildings and Structures: \$30.00 for each structure, including but not limited to fences, and attached garages and decks; and
 - (4) Current State of Wisconsin Seal charge, plus \$10.00.
 - (5) Early Start Fee: \$50.00
 - (6) Occupancy Permit: \$30.00 per unit.
 - (7) Zoning Letter: \$30.00

- (b) All other buildings except single family dwellings and duplexes:
 - (1) Site Plan Review Fee: \$125.00; and
 - (2) Building Permit Fee: \$100.00 plus \$0.02 per square foot of floor area. If appropriate floor area calculation can not be made, the fee shall be based upon the construction costs with a fee of \$40.00 plus 0.15% of construction costs.
 - (3) Accessory Buildings and Structures (including warehouses and unheated storage buildings): \$40.00 plus \$0.015 per square foot of floor area.
 - (4) Occupancy Permit: \$50.00
 - (5) Early Start Fee: \$100.00
 - (6) Parking Lot Review:
 - (6)A 0 to 10,000 sq ft: \$ 40.00
 - (6)B 10,001 to 20,000 sq ft: \$ 60.00
 - (6)C 20,001 to 40,000 sq ft: \$ 80.00
 - (6)D 40,001 sq ft and over: \$100.00
 - (7) Elevator: \$40.00
 - (8) Zoning Letter: \$30.00
 - (c) Certified Survey Map Review: \$150.00
- (2) Remodeling Buildings or Structures (Includes Re-Siding).
- (A) Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes:
 - (1) \$50.00 plan approval fee; and
 - (2) \$30.00 plus \$0.20 per square foot of floor area. If appropriate floor area calculation can not be made, the fee shall be based upon the construction costs with a fee of \$30.00 plus 0.15% of construction costs. (Maximum total fee of \$500.00 per unit).
 - (B) All other buildings except single family dwellings and duplexes (including accessory structures):
 - (1) \$30.00 plus 0.3% of construction costs, over \$4,000.00.
- (3) Wrecking Buildings.
- (A) 500 square feet or less floor area: \$30.00
 - (B) 501 or more square feet floor area: \$60.00
- (4) Moving Buildings.
- (A) 500 square feet or less floor area: \$30.00
 - (B) 501 or more square feet floor area: \$60.00
 - (C) plus proof of insurance pursuant to Village Ordinance
- (5) Street Occupancy During Construction. Permit shall be

obtained from the Village Engineer.

- (6) Reinspection fee (because of non-compliance on final inspections): \$50.00.
- (7) Failure to call for Inspection: \$50.00

C. Heating and Central Air Conditioning.

- (1) Air conditioner, furnace or boiler replacement (no ductwork added): \$10.00 per source unit
- (2) On all new installations, heating and air conditioning permit fees shall be based on the estimated total labor, materials and equipment costs as follows:
 - (a) Up to \$1,000: \$20.00
 - (b) \$1,001 to \$2,500: \$30.00
 - (c) \$2,501 to \$4,000: \$35.00
 - (d) \$4,001 to \$6,000: \$40.00
 - (e) \$6,001 to \$8,000: \$45.00
 - (f) \$8,001 to \$10,000: \$50.00
 - (g) Over \$10,000: \$50.00 plus \$2.00 per \$1,000, or part thereof, in excess of \$10,000 except that there shall be no fee required for service work which involves normal maintenance, which is done to assure proper operation and safety of equipment.

D. Construction Site Erosion Control. Application fee:

- (1) Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes: \$50.00 per lot.
- (2) All other buildings except single family dwellings and duplexes: Refer to Section 8.23 A.

E. Rounding of Fees: All fees shall be rounded to the nearest whole dollar with the minimum fee being one dollar (\$1.00).

F. Definitions: For the purpose of this subsection

- (1) Construction costs include all materials and labor. [Example: If construction costs equal \$80,000.00, and the fee is \$40.00 plus 0.15% of construction costs, the fee is calculated as follows: $\$40.00 + (0.0015 \times \$80,000.00) = \$160.00$]
- (2) Area calculations include all floor levels, basements, garages, and all space enclosed by a roof, except single family dwellings and duplexes do not include unfinished basement space in the calculation.
- (3) Early Start Fee is for work commenced prior to site plan approval. It is non-refundable and not applicable to any other fee.

A. Canvassers, solicitors, peddlers:

8.05 ELECTRICAL.

A. Permit Fees.

MAXIMUM FEE - COMMERCIAL \$500.00 RESIDENTIAL \$300.00

MINIMUM FEE - COMMERCIAL \$ 75.00 RESIDENTIAL \$ 50.00

FOR REMODELING, ADDITIONS, NEW CONSTRUCTION \$.03 SQUARE FOOT

- (1) Re-inspections \$50.00
- (2) Failure to call for inspection \$50.00
- (3) MINIMUM PERMIT FEE \$50.00

8.06 FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES AND INTOXICATING LIQUORS. (See Sec. 23.05).

A. The annual fee for fermented malt beverage and intoxicating liquor licenses shall be as follows:

- (1) For a "Retail Class A" license for fermented malt beverages, \$250.
- (2) For a "Retail Class B" license for fermented malt beverages, \$100.
- (3) For a "Wholesaler's License" for fermented malt beverage, \$25.
- (4) For a "Special Wholesaler's License" for fermented malt beverages, \$25.
- (5) For a "Retail Class A" license for intoxicating liquors, \$250.
- (6) For a "Retail Class B" license for intoxicating liquors,

\$400.

- (7) For a "Temporary Operator's License" which is valid for one twenty-four hour period, \$10.00.
 - (8) For a publication fee for a "Retail Class A" Fermented Malt Beverage, "Retail Class A" Intoxicating Liquors, "Retail Class B" Fermented Malt Beverage or "Retail Class B" Intoxicating Liquors, license, \$60.00.
 - (9) For a "Picnic Beer License" for selling fermented malt beverages at social events, \$10.00.
 - (10) For a "Picnic Wine License" for selling wine or wine coolers at social events, \$10.00.
- B. License transfer fee from one premises to another within the Village is \$10.00. (See Sec. 23.12).
 - C. Operator's License Fee for a 2-year period, expiring on June 30th of the second year: \$40.00
 - D. Provisional operator's license shall be \$15.00 for a 60-day period. (See Sec. 23.15 F).
 - E. Reserve Retail Class B License.

The fee for the initial issuance of a Reserve Retail Class B License for fermented malt beverages or for intoxicating liquors shall be \$10,000.00, which shall be payable in addition to the annual license fee provided by Section 8.06 A. This initial fee shall not be payable by a bona fide club or lodge which is situated and incorporated in the State of Wisconsin, and which has been situated and incorporated in this State for at least six years.

8.07 FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS.

- A. Permit fees for installation or removal of underground/aboveground storage tanks shall be as follows:
 - 0 - 1000 gal. = \$45.00 per tank
 - 1001 - 3000 gal. = \$60.00 per tank
 - 3001 - 5000 gal. = \$75.00 per tank
 - 5001 - up gal. = \$90.00 per tank

8.08 HOUSING.

A rooming house permit fee shall be \$5.00 plus \$2.00 for each dwelling

unit or rooming unit.

8.09 JUNK DEALERS AND AUTO SALVAGE DEALERS.

Every junk dealer or auto salvage dealer shall pay an annual license fee of \$250.00.

8.10 NUISANCES.

A. Abandoned Vehicles.

An impounded abandoned vehicle sold at auction will incur a \$100.00 daily storage fee after the second business day subsequent to the sale date.

Any listing of vehicles to be so sold shall be made available upon payment of a \$5.00 fee to the Village.

8.11 PLUMBING.

A. Schedule of Fees.

- (1) Municipal Sanitary Sewer Connection Fee: \$30.00
- (2) Private sewer main: \$30.00
- (3) Water well: \$30.00
- (4) Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes: (new, additions, remodeling) permit fees shall be based on the number of fixtures as follows:

Up to 6 fixtures: \$40.00, plus \$5.00 per additional fixture.
- (5) All other Buildings except Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes (new, additions, remodeling) shall be based upon the floor area calculation of the project as follows:
 - (A) Minimum \$40.00 plus \$0.15 per square foot over 10,000 square feet.
 - (B) Maximum commercial fee is \$2,500.00.
- (6) Warehouse, cold storage or similar where plumbing installation is limited to drain lines, storm drains, or 6 sanitary fixtures or less, the fee shall be based upon:
 - (A) \$40.00 for the first \$3,000 of construction costs

plus 1.00% of additional construction costs.

- (7) Commercial Water Connection Fee: \$30.00
- (8) Municipal Storm Sewer Connection Fee: \$30.00
- (9) Residential Lawn Sprinkler: \$30.00
- (10) Commercial Lawn Sprinkler: \$30.00
- (11) Fire Suppression System: \$0.02 per square foot of floor area (max \$1,500).
- (12) Reinspection Fee for Noncompliance: \$50.00
- (13) Permit Fee to Abandon Sewer and Water Connection: \$50.00

B. Normal Sewer Service Charge.

Based on quantity of water used, as measured by the Village of Allouez Water Dept. Such sewer service charge will be as follows, but in no case shall be less than the minimum monthly fixed sewer charge as established by the Village.

- (1) Residential Users:
\$.391 per 100 gallons of water metered or sewage discharged.
- (2) Commercial and Public Users:
\$.391 per 100 gallons of water metered or sewage discharged.
- (3) Industrial Users:
 - (a) \$.391 per 100 gallons of water metered or sewage discharged.
 - a. All users having volumes in excess of 3,000,000 cubic feet per year, concentrations in excess of 200 parts per million of BOD or suspended solids, concentrations in excess of 10 parts per million of phosphorus or concentrations in excess of 27 parts per million of TKN, in the sewage discharges; shall have metering and sampling as required by the Village and the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District. Users shall be billed for excess over normal concentrations at the following rates:

\$0.60 per 1000 gallons flow

\$0.25 per pound of BOD
 \$0.25 per pound of suspended solids
 \$1.00 per pound of phosphorus
 \$0.50 per pound of TKN

C. Industrial Waste Metering Device Fees.

Any user of an industrial waste metering device as authorized by Section 15.27 E. shall pay the following fee, as determined by the user's water meter size:

8.12 STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

A. Curbs and Gutters.

Permit fee to cut, remove or alter an existing concrete curb or gutter to provide driveway access to private property.

- (1) Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes: \$50.00 per cut.
- (2) All other buildings except single family dwellings and duplexes: \$100.00 per cut.

B. Street Crossing by Boring or Tunneling

The permit fee to bore under a street or sidewalk, or tunnel into or under sections of street, public right-of-way, and public utility easements in order to install a utility lateral or utility service including electrical, video, telecommunications or other service shall be \$375.00 per boring per street crossing. This permit fee includes permit issuance and one site inspection of the completed work. Any additional inspection or other engineering and inspection services provided by the Village shall be invoiced to the permittee as incurred. In addition, each boring pit or minor excavation in the right-of-way or public utility easement in addition to any street crossing shall pay an additional permit fee of \$75.00 per boring pit or excavation. Potholing in conjunction with a project are included in the permit fee. Permit fees for a single family residence are covered under section 8.11.

C. Street Crossing by Open Cut Excavation

The permit fee to open cut excavate a street or sidewalk, or excavate and fill sections of street right-of-way, public right-of-

way and public utility easements in order to install a utility lateral or utility service including electrical, video, telecommunications or other service shall be \$750.00 per open cut excavation. This fee includes permit issuance and one site inspection of the completed work. Any additional inspection or other engineering and inspection services provided by the Village shall be invoiced to the permittee as incurred. Potholing in conjunction with a project are included in the permit fee. Permit fees for a single family residence are covered under section 8.11.

D. Soil Borings

The permit fee to bore into a street right-of-way or public utility easement for soils investigations shall be \$50.00 per boring or for monitoring site contamination or remediation including well installation shall be \$100.00 per boring or well.

E. Electrical and Gas Service

The permit fee to provide or install electrical service or natural gas service to a property shall be \$50.00.

8.13 TREES.

A. Removal of Trees and Plantings.

- (1) For the Village to replant a tree pursuant to Section 4.11 A (2) (a): \$75.00 plus the actual cost of the tree.

8.14 SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLES.

A. Hauler's License.

The license fee for any one calendar year or any fraction thereof shall be \$100.00 for the first vehicle and \$10.00 for each additional vehicle, operated by such person, firm or corporation. The fee shall be due on January 1st of each calendar year. If not paid the penalty shall be \$100 per day per vehicle and each day shall be considered a separate violation.

B. Charge for Bulky Items During a Non-Pickup Week.

If there are bulky items left at the curb during a non-pickup week forty-eight (48) hours after the date of notice to a property owner, the Village will pick up the items and property owner will be charged the following:

Minimum Charge:	\$100.00
1-4 cubic yards:	\$100.00
5-6 cubic yards:	\$150.00

7-8 cubic yards: \$200.00
9-10 cubic yards: \$250.00

Any unpaid charges will be placed on the real estate tax bill as a special charge.

8.15 SIGNS.

A. Permit Fees.

- (1) Temporary Signs: \$40.00 for 30 days
- (2) Permanent Signs: \$40.00 or \$0.50 per square foot, whichever sum is greatest.
- (3) Reinspection fee because of violations on final inspections: \$20.00

8.16 ZONING.

A. Planned Development District.

- (1) Application fee: \$500.00.
- (2) Amendment of final approval fee: \$300.00.

B. Board of Appeals.

- (1) Application fee: \$150.00

C. Conditional Use.

- (1) Application fee: \$300.00

D. Rezoning Petitions.

- (1) Application fee: \$200.00.

8.17 CABLE TELEVISION.

- A. Annual Franchise Payment: The grantee of a cable television franchise shall pay an annual franchise fee of five percent (5%) of the grantee's local annual gross revenues, or such sum as shall be established by the franchise agreement, whichever amount is greatest.

8.18 FLOOD PLAIN

A. FLOOD PLAIN Land Use Permit:

- (1) Single Family Dwellings and Duplexes: \$50.00

- (2) All other buildings except single family dwellings and duplexes: \$75.00

8.19 PAWNBROKERS, SECONDHAND ARTICLE AND SECONDHAND JEWELRY DEALERS.

A. Annual license fees:

- (1) Pawnbroker - \$210.00.
- (2) Secondhand article dealer - \$27.50.
- (3) Secondhand jewelry dealer - \$30.00.

8.20 CIGARETTE AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS RETAILER LICENSE.

License from July 1, or when applied for, of each year and continuing in force until the following June 30 unless sooner revoked: \$100.00.

8.21 MUNICIPAL COURT FEES

- A. Reopening a Municipal Court Judgment. A non-refundable \$50.00 fee per citation or per judgment. Such reopening requires approval of the Municipal Judge.

8.22 LATERAL CONNECTION AND INSPECTION FEES

- A. The connection and inspection fee for a potable water service to a residential property is \$100.00 and includes inspection of the service when installed.
- B. The connection and inspection fee for a sanitary sewer service lateral to a residential property is \$100.00 and includes inspection of the lateral when installed.
- C. The connection and inspection fee for a storm lateral to a residential property is \$100.00 and includes inspection of the lateral when installed.

8.23 STORM WATER MANAGEMENT FEES

A. Construction Site Erosion Control

The permit fee for construction site erosion control for a permit required under Ordinance No. 52 Construction Site Erosion Control for land disturbing activity shall be a permit fee of \$250.00 plus the estimated inspection fees for compliance with the erosion control ordinance. The estimated inspection fees will be provided at the time of permit issuance and will be invoiced for payment at that time. If it is determined the permittee is not in compliance with Ordinance No. 52 and additional inspections are required, these will be invoiced as incurred and the permittee agrees to pay these additional charges.

B. Post Construction Storm Water Management

The permit fee for evaluation of the post construction storm water management program and a permit if required under Ordinance No. 53 Post Construction Storm Water Management shall be a permit fee of \$1000.00 plus the estimated inspection fees for compliance with the permit requirements for any storm water treatment facility provided by the permittee. The estimated inspection fees will be provided at the time of permit issuance and will be invoiced for payment at that time. If it is determined that the permittee is not in compliance with Ordinance No. 53 and additional inspections or engineering time is required, these will be invoiced as incurred and the permittee agrees to pay these additional charges.

C. Storm Water Fee in Lieu of

Refer to Ordinance No. 50 for determining this fee.

8.24 FALSE ALARM FEES

- (1) An alarm user shall pay to the Village Clerk-Treasurer within 10 days after activation, the following service fees for false alarms: These charges are per calendar year.

First False Alarm	No charge if a permit is on file. \$25.00 charge if a permit is <u>not</u> on file and an application for permit is mailed with the invoice.
Second False Alarm	\$25.00
Third False Alarm	\$50.00
Each Subsequent False Alarm	\$75.00

8.25 RE-ESTABLISHED BULKHEAD LINES

- A. A non-refundable fee of \$125.00 shall be paid by any person requesting a re-established bulkhead line.

8.26 CHARGE FOR RESCUE SQUAD CALL TRANSPORT

Effective January 1, 2009 the Village's charge for a rescue squad call transport is:
