

## CHAPTER 9

### PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES, ACTIVITIES, PROGRAMS AND PERSONNEL

#### 9.01 PUBLIC PARKS.

Unlawful Conduct. No person shall, in any public park within the Village of Allouez:

- A. Park any motor vehicle except within the limits of clearly marked parking areas.
- B. Operate any motor vehicle, or ride a horse except upon clearly marked public roadways.
- C. Operate any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour.
- D. Park any motor vehicle, or loiter or lounge between 10:00 o'clock p.m. and 6:00 o'clock a.m. on the following morning, except as allowed by permit issued by the Village Board.

- F. Disturb, molest, deface, remove or destroy any tree, shrub, plant or other natural growth; carve or paint on any rock, sign, wall or structure; drive a nail in tree, or injure or deface in any manner, any park building, sign, fence, table or other Village property.
- G. Dig or break up the ground surface anywhere except as allowed by permit issued by the Village Board.
- H. Build any fire except in a fireplace or approved grill, or dispose of live embers of any fire in any place where such embers may start a grass or forest fire or endanger public health or safety.
- I. Leave, throw or break any bottle, box, can, garbage or other object except in a clearly marked refuse receptacle.
- J. Set off fireworks of any kind, except as allowed by permit issued by the Village Board.
- K. Engage in any athletic contest, game or activity, except in areas designated for such activity.
- L. Be intoxicated, use profane language, or engage in any conduct of a disorderly nature.
- M. Use any public facility in any manner which is destructive to that facility.
- N. Fail, refuse or neglect to obey any rule or regulation, or posted notice or sign of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Maintenance Department, or any law enforcement agency, pertaining to the use or enjoyment of any facilities upon such public grounds.
- O. Consume any alcoholic beverage, except within the boundaries of Green Isle Park.
