

# DRIVEWAY SPECIFICATIONS

Building code requirements as detailed in Village ordinances 3, 5, and 11.

<b>Permitted Uses</b> 11.03:	Paved or surfaced areas which provide ingress and egress to parking areas or garages.
<b>Building Permit Fee –</b> 8.12	Single family dwellings and duplexes: \$50.00 per cut All other structures: \$100.00 per cut
<b>General Provisions –</b> 11.04(H):	All driveways in “A” or “B” Residence Districts, with the exception of existing unpaved driveways as of December 6, 2011, must be paved with a hard surface material.
<b>Maximum Driveway Size</b> 3.04:	30 feet wide from the curb to the property wide and 40 feet in wide beyond the property line. Duplexes with continuous driveways, exceeding 30 feet in width, must have an 8 inch high by 6 inch wide curb separating the two driveways at the street edge.
<b>Curbs and Gutters</b> 3.05:	No street shall be permanently improved without the installation of a curb and gutter on each side. Alterations to an existing curb or gutter require a curb permit. Removal of concrete curbs for driveway access to private property must comply with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- A saw joint at least 1 inch deep shall be cut in the gutter section for the full length of the proposed driveway opening.</li><li>- The header shall be removed in full depth of the curb section.</li><li>- A continuous gutter section for storm water shall be maintained.</li><li>- A ¾ inch expansion joint shall be placed along between the curb and the lot line.</li></ul>
<b>Obstructions and Encroachments</b> 3.14:	No person shall encroach upon or in any way obstruct or encumber any public way to which adjoins to the owner or occupant’s premises.

This information shall not be considered as a full comprehensive view of the Village driveway code. All applicable code provisions shall be followed.
