Special Voting Deputies appointed by the Village of Allouez Clerk will be administering absentee voting for the residents of these facilities for the **November 8 General Election** at the above time and place. Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may vote by absentee ballot. A qualified elector is a U.S. citizen, age 18 or older on Election Day, who has resided in an election district for 10 consecutive days before any election where the person offers to vote, and is not currently serving a felony sentence. The elector must be registered to vote prior to being issued an absentee ballot.

Voters at these residential care facilities are not required to provide proof of identification when voting absentee.

Family members of voters residing in these care facility may be present when the SVDs conduct absentee voting at the facility and they may assist the voter if the voters so request.

One election observer from each of the two recognized political parties whose candidates for governor or president received the greatest number of votes in the municipality at the most recent general election may accompany the SVDs to each facility where absentee voting will take place. Each party wishing to have an observer present shall submit the name of the observer to the municipal clerk no later than the close of business on the last business day prior to the visit. No other observers may be present during absentee voting conducted by SVDs. This includes members of the media. SVDs will establish observation areas to allow observers to view all public aspects of the absentee voting process without disrupting the voting process.
