

Village of Allouez
Summary of Police Activity
2011



The information represented in this report was obtained by searching call records from the Computer Assisted Dispatch system used by the Brown County Communications Center and the in-car computers of all Officers in Brown County. Any type of call that is initiated by an officer or called in by a citizen is entered into this system. Some of the calls entered are cancelled, but there is an officer response to the vast majority of them.



Total calls involving Allouez assigned Deputies



Monthly breakdown of total Allouez calls in 2010 & 2011.




Traffic Crashes




In 2011 there were 359 traffic crashes reported in the Village of Allouez compared to 296 in 2010. In 2011 Deputies assigned to Allouez responded to 276 crashes while County assigned Deputies responded to 63. Traffic crashes resulting in injuries or serious road blockage typically require a second Deputy be dispatched to assist with traffic control and/or taking witness statements.

Alarms




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 134 alarm calls compared to 140 in 2010. In 2011 Deputies assigned to Allouez responded to 103 alarms and County assigned Deputies responded to 31 alarms. These calls would routinely be residential or commercial burglar alarms. During alarm calls the Allouez Deputy and a county Deputy are typically dispatched. At times the Deputies are cancelled when proper code is given to the alarm company to cancel.

Animal Calls




In 2011 and 2010 the Village of Allouez had 227 animal calls. In 2011 Deputies assigned to Allouez responded to 164 of the calls and County assigned Deputies responded to 63. These calls would commonly be complaints about loud animals, animal bites, loose animals, or to check the welfare of an animal.

Burglary




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had a total of 56 burglary complaints compared to 54 in 2010. In 2011 Deputies assigned to Allouez responded to 49 of the calls and Deputies assigned to the County responded to 7. It is common for the Allouez Deputy and a county Deputy to be initially dispatched to confirm that the scene is secure.

Damage to Property




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had a total of 57 damage to property complaints compared to 91 in 2010. In 2011 Deputies assigned to Allouez responded to 55 of the calls and Deputies assigned to the County responded to 2 calls. These calls routinely include acts of vandalism.

Disturbances




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 141 disturbance calls compared to 204 in 2010. Of the 141 calls in 2011 Allouez assigned Deputies handled 130 of the calls and county assigned Deputies handled 11 of the calls. Disturbance calls include physical and verbal arguments as well as domestic violence incidents. Unless the disturbance is being reported after the incident occurred the call always requires a back-up officer which is usually a county assigned Deputy. The back-up officer assists in the investigation by questioning people involved and taking witness statements.

Fraud




In 2011 the Village of Allouez received 58 fraud complaints compared to 65 in 2010. Allouez assigned Deputies handled 50 of the calls while county assigned Deputies handled 8 of the calls in 2011. These calls include complaints of phone scams as well as issues such as bad checks which are often civil matters and referred to the District Attorney's Office.

Harassment




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 71 harassment complaints compared to 99 in 2010. In 2011 Allouez assigned Deputies handled 59 of the calls while county assigned Deputies handled 12. These calls include complaints including unwanted contact from people such as phone calls or text messages.

Person




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 438 suspicious vehicle/situation/person complaints compared to 435 in 2010. In 2011 Allouez assigned Deputies handled 377 of the calls while county assigned Deputies handled 61. Common suspicious activity calls include vehicles/people in parks after hours or people/vehicles in areas that have had recent criminal activity. These calls can be citizen reports of suspicious activity or officer initiated. These calls often include two or more officers checking the area and sometimes lead to arrests for burglary, theft, or damage to property.

Theft




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 143 theft complaints compared to 171 in 2010. In 2011 Allouez assigned Deputies handled 132 of the calls and county assigned Deputies handled 11. Theft complaints include any theft of property and often include thefts from vehicles.

Traffic Stops




In 2011 1,792 traffic stops were conducted by Brown County Sheriff’s Deputies within the Village of Allouez compared to 1,702 in 2010. This includes Deputies assigned to Allouez, Deputies assigned to county sections, and the Brown County Sheriff’s Office Traffic Team. In 2011 Allouez assigned Deputies made 1,386 traffic stops and county assigned Deputies made 406 traffic stops within the Village. A search of only Deputies assigned to Allouez shows that 1,620 traffic stops were made by Allouez Deputies. This would include stops made outside the Village limits for violations observed in the Village. Many traffic stops lead to arrests for warrants, narcotics, or operating while intoxicated which would require a county Deputy be dispatched as back-up. In 2011 a total of 1,253 citations were written to the Allouez Municipal Court. This includes traffic and ordinance citations written by both Allouez and county Deputies. Other traffic stops may result in traffic crimes such as operating while revoked which are required to go to circuit court.

Battery




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 31 battery complaints compared to 19 in 2010. Battery complaints usually occur after the incident has occurred. According to the computer records Allouez Deputies handled 7 of the complaints and county Deputies handled 24. It should be noted that many disturbance calls also result in battery charges.

Sex Offences




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 14 sexual offence complaints compared to 17 in 2010. Allouez Deputies handled 8 of the call while county Deputies handled 6. These calls include sexual assaults and lewd & lascivious behavior calls. It is common for sexual assault calls to begin at a hospital and many times an investigator is sent instead of the Allouez Deputy.

Motorist Assist




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 353 motorist assist calls compared to 315 in 2010. Allouez Deputies handled 218 of the calls while county Deputies handled 135 of the calls. Motorist assist calls usually consist of assisting with broken down vehicles or vehicles in the ditch. Deputies assist the driver with removing the vehicle and clearing the scene. At times vehicles break down in traffic which presents an additional hazard especially on 172. It is not uncommon for an additional Deputy to be dispatched to assist with traffic control.

911 Assist/ Hang-ups




In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 269 911 hang-up/assist calls compared to 310 in 2010. Allouez Deputies handled 183 of the calls while county Deputies handled 86. 911 hang-ups usually consist of children playing with the phone or someone dialing a phone number with 911 in it. At times the calls do end up being an emergency. Two officers are always dispatched to 911 hang-up calls until it is confirmed if there is an emergency or not.

Medical Calls



In 2011 the Village of Allouez had 615 medical calls compared to 749 in 2010. It is not uncommon for Deputies not to respond to medical calls in situations where no Deputy is available, when the call is not a true emergency, or when the call occurs at a medical facility.

Allouez Cases Assigned to Investigative



According to Sheriff's Office records in 2011 72 cases that began in the Village of Allouez were assigned to an Investigator for follow-up compared to 80 in 2010. All incident reports are sent to the Investigative Division to be reviewed. Reports that have information that can be followed-up on will be assigned to an investigator. In certain cases depending on the incident an Investigator will respond to the scene to assist. Many reports are not assigned to Investigators, these reports would include property crimes were there is no suspect and no evidence or information to follow-up with.

Activity of DEO Loppnow

From June through the end of 2011 Deputy Loppnow was involved on 302 total police calls as well as working with the neighborhood watch, beginning the Landlord Alert Program, working with Probation & Parole to keep track of sex offenders, working on nuisance properties, taking care of Village police equipment, and other projects. This activity resulted in 92 traffic or ordinance citations issued to the Allouez Municipal Court, one arrest for a state charge, and 6 warrant arrests.
