

Q1 Do you reside in the Village of Allouez?



Q2 What is the age range of the person completing the survey?











Q7 Rate your satisfaction with village trails.



Q8 Rate your satisfaction with Allouez recreation programs.







Q14 Should the village plow snow from paved trails during the winter to allow for year round use?



Q15 Should the village explore the renovation/remodeling of the Allouez Community Center on Webster Avenue?


