LEAD SERVICES IN THE VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ

The following report is an evaluation and report on the presence of remaining lead services in the village of Allouez. There remains a small number of water services in the village that are lead. As of the date of this memo, there are approximately 125 lead services.

The lead services are in almost all cases short sections of lead pipe that remain in the street right of way (between the water main and the curb). These might be from 2 ft long to maybe up to 8-12 ft long, though most are less than 6 feet.

These lead services will continue to be removed as street projects are completed, or removed each year as funds are available to do so.

The report indicates that the concentration of lead in the village drinking water is very low and within the requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The Allouez Water Utility does add a low dose phosphate to its drinking water to control lead and copper.

Residents can check whether a lead service is identified for a property, or if a lead service has been removed, by observing the enclosed village map of lead services.

If a resident with a lead service, or a lead service that has been removed, would like a water sample tested please contact the Allouez Water Utility. The resident will be required to assist in the sampling by collecting the sample at a kitchen faucet, and the Water Utility will have the sample tested and report the results back to the resident. There is no cost for the testing.
