3 top issues/concerns regarding the village and proposed resolution (no references to past or present board members or actions):

1. Economic Growth – Although the ability to expand the village beyond its current borders is not possible, I believe that we could continue to court business to fill vacant properties and commercial spaces. Increasing the tax base through growing businesses is paramount to maintaining or even lowering personal property taxes.
