



GREEN ISLE PAVILION

The pavilion is available for rental throughout the year. Times available for rental are 9a.m. to 10 p.m.

The pavilion is heated, has a gas fireplace, kitchen facilities, tables and chairs (enough to seat 160 people), and the use of the gazebo is included with the pavilion rental.

***Security Deposit:** In addition to the above rate, a **\$250.00 security deposit is required** at time of reservation.

NOTE: We do not hold the security deposit check; it is cashed. If you complete the general cleaning, and are out of the pavilion by the time stipulated on the contract, the deposit will be refunded to you approximately two weeks after the event.

- **Cleaning includes:**

1. Sweep pavilion, kitchen, & bathrooms – broom & dustpan are provided.
2. Wipe any spills on floor.
3. Clean kitchen area: Scour sink, clean inside refrigerator/freezer, stove top & all counter tops.
4. Wipe down tables & Chairs; put back where they belong.

Category Descriptions

Category 1: Government Agencies, Non-Profit Organizations, Recreational Groups within the Village of Allouez.

***Category 1 groups must make reservation at Village Hall and must show proof of exempt status at time of reservation.**

Category 2: Village of Allouez Residents, Charitable Groups within the Village of Allouez, Schools.

Category 3: Non-Residents of Allouez, For-Profit Businesses.

Examples:

Government Agencies: Department of Transportation, Department of Natural Resources, Brown County Library.

Non-Profit Organizations: (any group with 501 (c) (3) status): Boy/Girl Scouts, Youth Association Groups, YMCA.

Charitable Groups within the Village of Allouez: (any group without 501 (c) (3) status): Special Interest Groups, Church Organizations, Sports Teams/Clubs.

Non-Residents of Allouez: Any individual who lives outside of the Allouez Village limits.

For-Profit Businesses: Any group or individual who operates for a profit.

Garbage bags are provided. Please separate Recycling from garbage.

Pots, pans, dishes, silverware, etc. are not provided.

Cleaning supplies are not provided – please bring your own.

OUTSIDE AND AROUND PAVILION

Chairs can be put outside

Numerous mature trees for plenty of shade in and around pavilion

Use of the grill (grill size 30" wide X 5' long)

Park benches and picnic tables available for use.

Absolutely no tents allowed, because of underground wiring

Music Outside:

-Music played outside the pavilion may require a noise-variance permit
