

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 163-2, REGISTRATION, OF CHAPTER 163, BICYCLES OF THE VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ MUNICIPAL CODE

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN THAT SECTION 163-2 BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

§ 163-2 Registration.

- A. Required. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a bicycle on any street, highway or public way or public property within the Village of Allouez unless such bicycle is properly registered and has displayed on it a valid and current tag of such registration.
- B. Applications. Duplicate applications for registration shall be made by the owner on forms provided by the Village Board or by representatives thereof designated by the Village of Allouez, and said applications shall contain the name, age, and address of the owner, and/or parent name, and a description of the bicycle, including the serial number thereof, and if said bicycle has no serial number, the Village Board or its representatives designated shall assign one to it. The application shall contain such other information as the Village Board shall deem pertinent.
- C. ~~Registration is free. Fees; records. A resident of the Village who has not previously been issued a permanent license for his or her bicycle, and a nonresident of the Village who does not have both a current registration of his or her bicycle and have displayed on it a current registration tag, shall be issued a registration tag upon the payment of the fee required by Chapter 225, Fees and Charges. A resident of the Village who acquires ownership of a bicycle for which the immediately preceding owner has obtained a permanent license shall be issued a new permanent license upon the payment of the transfer fee required by Chapter 225.~~
- D. Tags. No bicycle shall be considered registered until a registration tag shall be affixed to the frame of such bicycle, which shall remain so affixed until re-registration, or until removed by the Municipal Judge for just cause.
- E. Transfer of ownership. It shall be the duty of every person who transfers the title of any bicycle to endorse upon the back of the registration card on the form there provided the name and address of the buyer, the date of the transfer and the name of the seller. It shall be the duty of the new owner ~~to transfer the register to their name of such bicycle to apply for transfer of registration thereof~~ within seven days of such transfer. ~~A fee shall be paid for the registration of such transfer as outlined in Chapter 225. The fee shall be paid by the transferee making such application. There is no fee for transferring a registration.~~

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
