Re: ACTION RE: SELECT CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT PROJECT FOR 2018 APPLICATION CYCLE

Date: 19 July 2018

Every year the village has the opportunity to apply for a grant, as a Certified Local Government (CLG), to fund a historic preservation project. In the past the village has received funding to pay for the Intensive Survey Report, three individual property nominations, and two district nominations.

Funding is increasingly becoming competitive, with the increased awareness of the historical tax credits available. Funding is typically awarded with priority being given to projects in the following order – intensive survey reports, district nominations, individual nominations, and miscellaneous projects. Priority is also given to municipalities that were not awarded funding the previous year.

Below is a list from our Intensive Survey Report (2012/2013), which identifies all properties eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. A check mark is used to show completed or in progress projects.
