PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING

Wednesday, December 12, 2018

5:30 P.M., Allouez Village Hall

In absence of Chairperson Genrich, Beyler was nominated to act as Chairperson.

Acting Chairperson Beyler called the meeting to order at 5:40pm.

Present: Rafter, Beyler, and Green

Also Present: Gehin and Lange

MODIFY/ADOPT AGENDA

Green/Rafter moved to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES from the November 14th, 2018 meeting

Rafter/Green moved to approve the minutes of November 14, 2018 meeting. Motion carried.

PUBLIC APPEARANCES

Jim Orourke, 2339 Oakwood Avenue

- About 2 ½ years ago the 5 year Public Works Street Plan was presented at a meeting held at St. Matthew's. Street projects included sidewalks and he would like this to be shared with residents so they have an opportunity to discuss.

DISCUSSION/ACTION: RECONSTRUCTION OF ST. JOSEPH STREET – PROPOSED ROADWAY WIDTHS (DPW Gehin).

- A review of the current design of W. St. Joseph Street and proposed changes to the reconstruction of W. St. Joseph Street was presented to the committee.
- 4 – 5 talking points to be considered
- 2017 Bike/Ped Plan recommendations
- The need to identify sidewalk or sidewalks
- Width of sidewalk 5' or 7'
- Street width current vs. proposed
- Challenges
- On street parking
- Impacts and cost

Rafter/Green moved to open the meeting for public input. Motion carried.

10 residents from the St. Joseph Condominium, 300, 356, 366, 300 W. St. Joseph provided comments, questions and concerns:

- Like the idea of a sidewalk
- Will the curve in the road be straightened out
- Would the hill be gone
- Happy, waiting to see what happens
- What is the time schedule
- What is the responsibility (financial) of the residents
- Will there be access to their home during construction
- Parking may be an issue
- Concerned about parking at the apartment complex
- Will they be kept informed

Jim Orourke, 2339 Oakwood Avenue.

- Would like to see sidewalks and bike lanes on both sides

Rafter/Green moved to return to regular order of business. Motion carried.

Gehin presented the staff recommended roadway width for St. Joseph Street:

- 36' back of curb to back of curb roadway width, including 2 – 12' lanes, 4' bike lanes and 24" curb and gutter.
- On the northside of the roadway a 5' to 7' sidewalk with a variable terrace width (ideally no less than 6').
- No sidewalk on the southside, due to the sloped topography and location of the existing properties. The construction of sidewalk would likely require a retaining wall along the middle third of the project.
- On street parking near Old Chapel Hill Apartments.

Rafter

- 7' wide sidewalk on the north side and 5' on the south side
- On street bike lanes

Green

- Look at sidewalk on the south side regarding cost
- Sidewalk for sure on the north side and bike lanes

Beyler

- Agrees sidewalks on both sides
- 5' on north side with bike lane and 8' multi-purpose trail on south side

Gehin recapped based on direction and input received from the public and committee members. The preliminary design will move forward with the following:

- 36' back of curb to back of curb roadway width, 2-12' lanes, 4' bike lanes, and 24" curb and gutter.

December 12, 2018 (Public Works Committee Meeting)

- Northside of the roadway include a terrace and 7' sidewalk and 8' parking lane adjacent to the Olde Chapel Hill Apartments.
- Southside of the roadway to include a terrace and 5' sidewalk.

The impacts and cost of the proposed section will be brought back to the Public Works Committee on the 9th of January for a final decision to be made on the proposed roadway width.

Green/Rafter moved to postpone to December 18, 2018. Motion carried.

RECONSTRUCTION OF W. ST. JOSEPH STREET PROPOSED ROADWAY WIDTHS

A final decision on the proposed roadway width is necessary to move forward with design and to keep the project on schedule. At the last Public Works Meeting the existing roadway conditions were reviewed and input was received on the desired roadway elements. From input received from residents, property owners and committee members the following roadway section was proposed:

Proposed Roadway Section

- Reduced roadway width – 36 ft BOC to BOC
 - 2 – 12 ft Lanes w/ On-Street bike accommodations – 4 to 5 ft
 - 24-Inch C&G
 - 7 ft Sidewalk w/ boulevard on the northside of the roadway
 - 8-ft parking Lane located adjacent to the Olde Chapel Hill Apartments
 - 5 ft sidewalk w/ boulevard on the southside of the roadway

Based on the input received at last month's Public Works Committee the Village has started the preliminary design of the project. By January's Public Works Committee meeting the impacts and cost associated with the proposed roadway section will be known. The preliminary (30%) design, impacts and cost will be reviewed at the meeting. The purpose of presenting this preliminary information is to finalize the roadway section for W. St. Joseph Street.
