Date: 02 May 2019

May is recognized by the National Parks Service and the Wisconsin Historical Society, as Historic Preservation Month. In the past, the village approved has approved a proclamation, recognizing May as Allouez Historic Preservation Month.

Attached is a proclamation recognizing May 2019 as Historic Preservation Month.

The Historic Preservation Committee recommended approval of the proclamation at the April 24, 2019 meeting. The fifth preamble was added after the committee meeting at the suggestion of a resident.

## *Proclamation for National Historic Preservation Month 2019*

*Whereas*, The National Trust for Historic Preservation established May as Historic Preservation Month in 1973, as a way to promote historic places for the purpose of instilling national and community pride, promoting heritage tourism, and showing the social and economic benefits of historic preservation; and

*Whereas*, The Wisconsin Historical Society recognizes May as Historic Preservation Month and sponsors annual events around the state of Wisconsin to instill awareness and promote the historic assets in Wisconsin; and

*Whereas*, Historic Preservation Month can instill awareness of the local historically significant buildings and landmarks to the residents of Allouez and surrounding communities; and

*Whereas*, Historic Preservation Month can promote the region's largest source of heritage tourism, Heritage Hill State Historical Park, located in the Village of Allouez; and

*Whereas*, Historic Preservation Month can bring awareness to the several individual properties listed to the National Register of Historic Places located in the village, as well as the collection of properties that make up the Miramar Drive Residential Historic District and Green Bay Correctional Institution; and

*Whereas*, Historic preservation can be a community discussion; uniting residents behind an important cause; and

*Whereas*, Historic preservation has been shown as a great way to create jobs, stabilize property values, and preserve existing housing stock;

*Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved*, That the Village of Allouez, does recognize May 2019 as National Historic Preservation Month and hereby proclaim May 2019 as Allouez Historic Preservation Month, and call upon the residents of Allouez to recognize and participate in this special observance.
